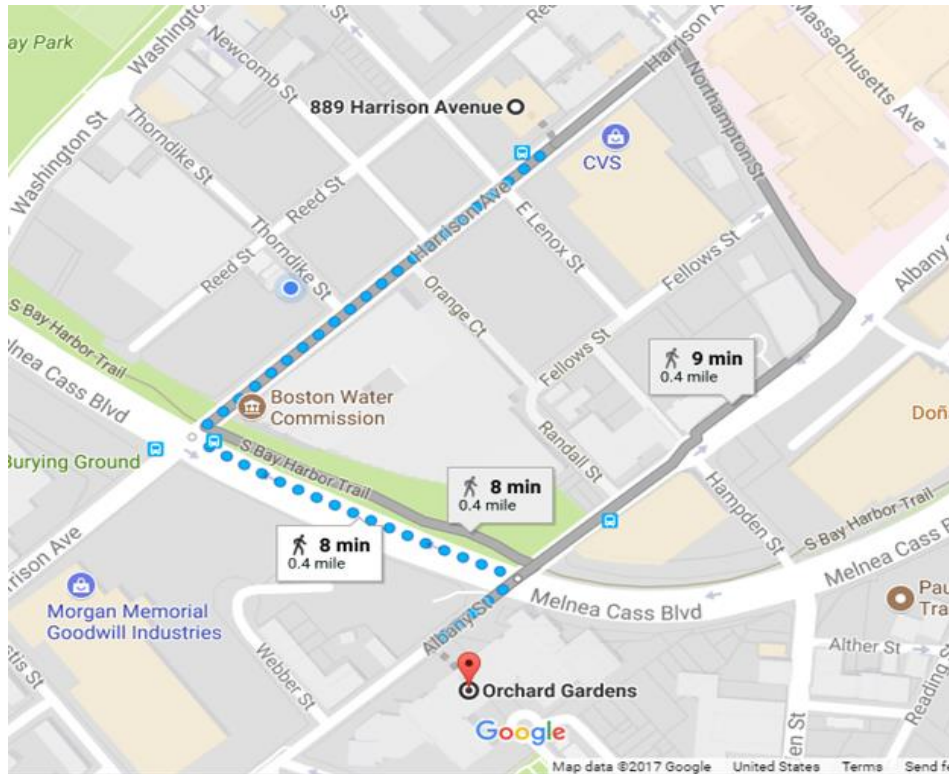
Question	Why Vote Yes?	Why Vote No?	Rosie's Place Encourages...
<p>Question 1: Nurse-Patient Assignment Limits</p>	<p>A YES vote would establish limits on the number of patients assigned to registered nurses working in hospitals.</p>	<p>A NO vote would keep things the way they are, with no legal limits set to how many patients a nurse can be assigned.</p>	<p>Vote YES! We believe that women should receive the best-quality healthcare. When nurses have too many patients to care for, it impacts the safety of all patients.</p>
<p>Question 2: Advisory Commission for Amendments to the U.S. Constitution regarding corporate personhood and political spending</p>	<p>A YES vote would establish a 15-member citizens' commission to advocate for certain amendments to the United States Constitution regarding campaign finance and corporate personhood.</p>	<p>A NO vote would not establish the commission.</p>	<p>Vote YES! Your voice matters. We believe that elections should be swayed by individual voters and their voices, not corporations.</p>
<p>Question 3: Gender Identity Anti-Discrimination Veto Referendum</p>	<p>A YES vote would support and uphold the current law that prohibits discrimination based on gender identity in public places – such as hotels, restaurants, and stores.</p>	<p>A NO vote would repeal the law that prohibits discrimination based on gender identity in public places.</p>	<p>Vote YES! We believe ALL women have equal rights and should be safe and protected by law in public spaces. We need more acceptance, not fear and discrimination.</p>

If you are registered to vote at **Rosie's Place**, you vote at **Orchard Gardens Community Center (906 Albany St.)**

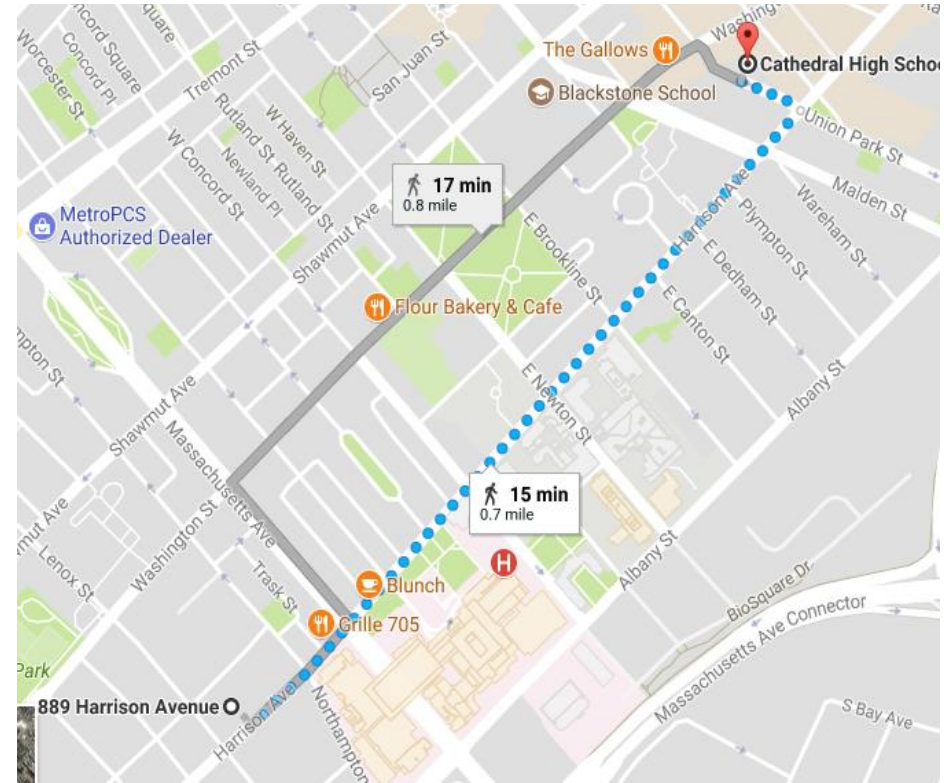


Directions from Rosie's Place:
